1 The Court, having reviewed the Twenty-Ninth Interim Fee Application of
2 Thomas Hebrank ("Receiver"), the Court-appointed receiver for Defendant PWCG
3 Trust, for Payment of Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses ("Application"),
4 including any supporting declarations and objections filed therein, and being so
5 advised in the matter and finding good cause, orders as follows:

6 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Receiver's Application is granted.

7 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Receiver's fees and costs for the
8 Twenty-Ninth Application Period are allowed and approved, on an interim basis, in
9 the amounts of \$14,982.75 and \$889.32.

10 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Receiver is authorized and directed to
11 pay himself \$11,986.20 in fees and \$889.32 in costs from assets of the receivership
12 estate, which amount reflects an interim payment of 80% of the allowed fees and
13 100% of the allowed costs.
